The board was structured and managed well. Each members role was made clear, and everyone was reminded to declare any interests and adhere to confidentiality. Academic staff provided clear summaries of each student and their progression status, explaining specific regulations in complex cases.

I started in July last year and examined work across 10 modules and provided the module delivery team with my feedback. There were no issues, and we remained in regular contact to discuss new assessment briefs.

I did not receive a report to complete due to some IT problems that the college experienced.

(c) The overall performance of the students, in relation to that of comparable levels of work in other institutions.

Considering it has been a difficult year for so many, the students performed very well. Students where I work, and at other institutions I have a connection with, have struggled to submit work on time and have had to request extra time; however, most students at Keighley college submitted work and did not submit claims for extra time This is a testament to the team's hard work and support to students. In addition, I did not see many cases of suspected plagiarism – well done to the teaching team and to the students for embracing good academic practice.

(d) The strengths and weaknesses of the students in general with respect to knowledge, conceptual grasp or application of skills.

On the whole students appeared to understand the key issues and were able to articulate these in their assessments. Going by student names, it appears that students who do not pass, or achieve the lower grades, are predominantly from BAME backgrounds; it would be good to know what plans the team are putting in place to address differences in attainment between ethnic groups.

Good range of summative assessments – in some modules students are required to submit two summative assessments, and this will be a lot of work for students (& staff). The team may want to review this in the near future. Moderation report provides a useful summary for the EE of the process undertaken to ensure quality and fairness.

An impressive pass rate across all modules. The team have managed the challenges of online study and clearly provided a lot of support to get students to this level.
